Provincial Jumping Championships and Medal Finals - with Ebon Stables and the SHF

New this year, the SHJA will help host provincial finals for the following heights:

2'9, 3'0, 3'3 and 3'6 Hunters and 0.85, 0.9, 1.0, 1.1, 1.15 and 1.20m jumpers.

This event will also be host to the SHJA Medal Finals for the 2'6,

3'0 and 3'3 SHJA Medals with the winners of these classes throughout the summer receiving free entry into their final!

High Performance Grants- in conjunction with SHF & Sask Sport

This is a long standing program administered by the SHJA. Junior and Amateur Riders showing at 1.10m and higher are encouraged to fill out the application form. Forms are due Nov.1, 2018.

SHJA Hunter Classic

The SHJA created this program in 2017, and will be offering again in 2018. The purpose of this program is to offer a class with heights that shows are not offering as divisions with the desire to increase both the height and number of competitors in the hunter ring.

Proposed Heights: 2'9", 3'0", 3'3", and 3'6" (options to 3" higher than rest of course if offered)

The class will offer prize money of \$500-\$750 with SHJA to supply 1/2 of the money. This class will only be offered at EC Gold events for 2018.

CET Mini Medals & SHJA Jr/AM Hunter Medals

The SHJA will, for the 2018 show season, be administering the CET Mini Medal program.

This class can be run in conjunction with the existing 3'3" SHJA Jumper Medal.

Shows wanting to run the CET Mini Medal/SHJA Jumper Medal or the 2'6 Jr/AM Hunter medal or the 3'0 Jr/AM Hunter medal will need to indicate their intent on the 2018 SHJA Sponsorship & Medal Request form. Deadline for application is April 30, 2018.

Year End Awards

The SHJA Year End awards consist of the following:

Development Hunter	up to and including 2'0"
Low Hunter	2'3" and up including 2'6"
Open Hunter	2'9" and up
Low Jumper	up to and including 1.00m
Medium Jumper	1.10m and up
Hunter of the Year Award	
Pony Award	(** requires 3 ponies to be nominated)
2'6" Medal	
3'0" Medal	
1.00m Jumper Medal/CET Mini Medal	

Points are tabulated from shows that request sponsorship for the current show year.

Individual membership for the current year is required to be considered for year-end

awards. In the past they have been Moose Jaw, Trophy Show, Signs of Summer, Summer Sun I-IV, Mid-Summer Masters, Hidden Meadows Ranch, and Saskatoon Classic.

SHJA Hunter of the Year Award

For the 2018 show season, the SHJA will continue the overall Hunter of the Year Award.

This award will be the accumulation of each hunter jumper show in Saskatchewan that holds an indicated special, hunter derby, and hunter classic classes. These classes can be at any height from 2'6" and up.

The SHJA Hunter Award will be handed out at the SHJA 2018 AGM.

Calculations will be as follows:

Class Placing X # of Entries X Height of Class

Horse #1: First Place 7 points x 10 entries x 3'0"=210 points

SHJA Pony Award

For the 2018 show season, the SHJA will continue the Pony Award. There will need three or more ponies declared for the year for the award to be handed out.

This award will be the accumulation of each hunter jumper show in Saskatchewan that holds any open hunter or jumper class. These classes can be at any height from 2'0" and up. All ponies are to be declared to the SHJA.

The SHJA Pony of the Year Award will be handed out at the SHJA 2018 AGM.

Calculations will be as follows:

Class Placing X # of Entries X Height of Class
