## SASKATCHEWAN HUNTER AND JUMPER ASSOCIATION 2019 Hunter Classic Criteria

## Purpose:

To offer Competition Organizing Committees a class with heights that are not currently offered as full divisions, with the desire to increase both the height, and number of competitors in the hunter ring.

## **Proposed Heights:**

2'9", 3'0", 3'3", and 3'6" (options to 3" higher than rest of course if offered)

### Class Specifications:

- Open to horses that have shown in at least one other EC "Gold" level Hunter Class /
  Division in the Competition unless the Hunter Classic is the only Hunter Class in the
  Competition. All Competitors in the Hunter Classic must be SHJA members in good
  standing in the current calendar year.
- 2. A course walk prior to the start of the class is permitted. (This is recommended, but will be left to the Organizing Committee discretion).
- 3. The Hunter Classic will be run as two (2) rounds, over the same or different course, with scores announced after the completion of every round.
- 4. The first round course is to consist of at least twelve (12) obstacles.
- 5. The Hunter Classic is offered at all four heights (2'9", 3'0", 3'3", and 3'6"). Entrants are to enter highest height they have competed in the show or higher at their discretion.
- 6. First round to begin a 2'9" and move up heights to the highest height there are entries, (may be altered at the shows discretion).
- 7. Top 12 scores are to return for the second round-returning by height either lowest to highest or highest to lowest. (This will be left to the Organizing Committee discretion.)
- 8. Horses to jog for soundness prior to placings being finalized and announced.
- 9. Show is required to be rated as an EC "Gold" show or higher.
- 10. Application form must be submitted and approved by SHJA before the Hunter Classic can be advertised in the Prize List.

#### SHJA:

- 1. The Class is to be a co-sponsored class with the SHJA getting top billing.
- 2. Half of the Class Fee to be put forward by show and the other half from the SHJA.
- 3. Proposed Class prize money \$500 to \$750 maximum.
- 4. Class will be count towards the SHJA Hunter of the Year Award.
- 5. Entry fee to be set at 10% of total prize money offered for the Class.
